- Visual ability to differentiate between colours and undertake close inspection of objects;
- Ability to work rapidly under emergency conditions;
- Ability to perform medium to heavy work requiring the lifting of items 20-50 pounds on a regular basis and upwards of 100 pounds on occasion;
