### Accessing receipts/records:

Please see the following links which may aid you in accessing your vaccine receipts/records. If your record does not appear please contact the service provider who administered your vaccination or public health. Any questions related to accessing your record in Canada should be directed to provincial public health.

<b>ONTARIO</b>	<p><a href="https://covid19.ontariohealth.ca/">https://covid19.ontariohealth.ca/</a></p> <p>Once you have agreed to the terms at bottom of this webpage you will be taken to a page where you will be asked to enter your personal identification information (your green health card is needed) in order to access your record.</p> <p>You may also call the Provincial Vaccine Information Line at 1-888-999-6488 (TTY for people who are deaf, hearing-impaired or speech-impaired: 1-866-797-0007) to ask for mailed copies of your record or for further assistance.</p> <p>Your local public health office may also aid you in ways to access your vaccination records.</p>
