

RAINYCREST RESPIRATORY OUTBREAK DECLARED OVER

Riverside Health Care in conjunction with the Northwestern Health Unit has declared the Respiratory Outbreak at Rainycrest Long Term Care over.

All non-medical absences, transfers, discharges and social activities have resumed. All visitors are now welcome.

Riverside is urging the public to refrain from visiting the Home if feeling unwell to avoid spreading infections to those most vulnerable.

Riverside continues to have our detailed safety procedures and infection prevention control practices in place, which are designed to ensure the health and safety of our staff, the community and those within our care. All visitors are advised to observe the following guidelines in place:

- Clean hands with sanitizer when entering the Home and when entering and exiting resident rooms. As well as following good hand hygiene etiquette throughout your visit.
- Masks are mandatory and must be worn at all times when in the Home. Masks may only be removed when sitting to dine with a resident.
- Maintain physical distancing wherever possible.
- Visitors are to refrain from visiting multiple residents.
- Answer all screening questions honestly.
- If you are feeling ill, please do not visit at this time.
