This is an update the on the status of the COVID-19 outbreaks at Rainycrest Long Term Care Home.

The East and West Wings of Rainycrest are still in COVID-19 Outbreak.

To further enhance our team's ongoing efforts to prevent the spread of COVID-19, additional precautions are being taken including, but not limited to:

Rainycrest East and West Wings

- Visitors limited to one (1) caregiver within the Residents room for East and West wings only,
- Isolation of COVID-19 positive and symptomatic individuals,
- Additional high touch cleaning practices,
- Cohorting residents and staff where possible,
- All admissions, transfers, discharges and group social activities are cancelled in the East and West wings until further notice.
- N95 masks will be required by both staff and visitors in designated areas,
- Staff need to wear goggles or face shields,
- Visitors require eye protection in designated areas.

We believe these added measures will enhance the Home's ability to reduce the risk of transmission. The Home is already testing staff twice a week.

The Outbreak Management Team will continue to monitor the situation. The care and safety of our residents, team members and families are a top priority, and we thank everyone for their understanding and continued support at this time.
